3. **Kid** writes the whole word, not just the letter that changed. Then climbs to the next rung.

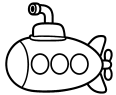

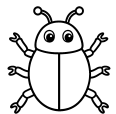

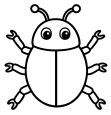
